February 2020 Meeting The Club Secretary's Report

Remember you can still enter the Hen Show in October even if you didn't show at the Cock Show. 36 birds were entered into this year's Cock Show which is the lowest entry since we started the Show League, although we have cut the amount of birds each exhibitor can show from 6 to 4. This was one of the changes we made to bring the scores closer as we felt it would be easier for Members to compete. Last year we decided to bring the show forward from March to February to suit some breeders who felt that by having the show in March it would damage the chance of their cocks breeding.

Another change was that the Members did the judging. I think these Members were the real winners. 33 got up and gave their opinion, it was like Brexit all over again. WELL DONE TO YOU ALL. There were still a few that were uncertain and didn't have a go, but you can have a go next time.

Our Winner of the Judging Competition was Joanne Farrant who was the only person who picked the first 3 birds but in the wrong order, winning £20.00 and our exclusive limited edition Dagenham CBS Key Ring which is not for sale.
