The President's Comments

At our last Sales Day we had a marvellous day with many sales tables with many species of birds and equipment.

I know these are only my thoughts, but could we not have two sales days, close together, but one in early Spring and one after the moult when there should be plenty of birds for sale when people sell off the birds they will not be using in the next breeding season? Surely this would bring in more people looking for birds for their next breeding season.

<u>Notes:</u> On looking at our Newsletter re: do's and don'ts for the Sales Day, I noticed the last paragraph said "No Seed or Plastic Equipment". Surely this is wrong. You are more or less saying out biggest Sponsor cannot be there to sell his seed and some plastic equipment!

Also, another Member cannot sell his plastic cages or other plastic and I believe someone else was also selling plastic nest boxes.

I think that paragraph should be re-worded or removed completely.

Perhaps we could have another Sales Day this year in September. Or, perhaps re-arrange our Hen Bird Show to September and go with a Sales Day in October when, hopefully, the moult should be over.

If anyone agrees, perhaps we could talk about this at our next Meeting.

Also, I noticed, that many Members were in the Hall way before time. Before our next Sales Day I would like to see it made clear that only those helping out on the day will be allowed in the Hall before the appropriate time.

What I have said is not said to make light of all that's done to try and help with the day's events.

However, once again, may I praise all those that arrange the Sales Days and all those that help get it ready and clear up after.

The Secretary's Comments

April was our second & final Bird Sale of 2024. There were lots of people in attendance and a nice buzz around the room. Well done and thank you to Jamie Taylor and Shane Evans, our sale managers, who liaised with the sellers and did lots of advertising running up to the sale. These sales give the members a chance to sell their stock or equipment and buyers to find that missing bird they need before the breeding season.

May's Meeting

Our next Meeting is on the 18th May and will be the Song Bird Competition with the winner being chosen by the Members.

This will be the fifth time Dagenham CBS has held the Song Bird Competition and the rules are simple. So whether you like the field song of a Goldfinch, the vocal power of the Canary, Mule or Green Singing Finch, or maybe the chatter of the Zebra Finch or Budgie, there will be something for you. Everyone has a favourite.

Members can enter as many birds as they like (£1.00 per bird). Birds can be in any suitable cage (it doesn't need to be a show cage). Each bird will be given a number and placed on the staging.

We can then all sit down and have a cup of tea and something to eat and talk about how the breeding season is going so far while all the birds are singing away.

At the end of the Meeting all Members present will be able to vote on which bird's song they liked the best and the winning bird will receive a rosette and a £20 cash prize.
